Dear San Diego Unified Family,

We understand that many families and colleagues are still recovering from last week's storm that brought record rainfall and severe flooding to our region. As district staff continue to support those impacted, we are preparing for another storm that is expected to deliver high winds, rain, and flooding to San Diego beginning early tomorrow. All San Diego Unified schools will remain open tomorrow, Thursday, February 1.

The City of San Diego recently issued an evacuation warning to people living in floodplain areas. We will continue to work with the City and continuously monitor the storm's impact on our schools and facilities, and will make additional staff available to assist schools in need of support.
